## Message from Mrs Johnstone and Mr Nicholls

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have finally come to the end of a very strange and difficult term. We have had a very busy last two weeks in school and all of the children and staff have been working extremely hard. We wanted to take this opportunity to thank everyone for all of their hard work and efforts. We are hopeful that the summer term will be much more settled for us all.

Last Friday was 'Wear a hat day' across school. Everyone looked fantastic wearing their hats. We especially liked the hats that were hand made in EYFS and Key Stage 1. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all parents, children and staff for their kind donations. On the actual day, we raised £564.70. Throughout this week, we have received even more donations. This means that altogether we have raised just over £685. Well done St Mark's this is absolutely fantastic and we are totally overwhelmed by your generosity. This money will be added together with the money raised by Etruscan Primary School and Watermill School and sent to Brain Tumour Research to help to fund research into finding a cure for brain tumours.

Due to an increase in food costs, the price of school meals are to change after the Easter holidays to £2.40 per day or £12 per week. Can we please ask that money is bought into school in an envelope, wallet or purse with your child's name and class clearly shown.


