Literacy

This half term, the children will begin to practise writing their names and forming letters correctly. It is really important that you help your child with this at home so that they are starting to get ready for when they in Reception.

In phonics, all of the children are now learning the letters of their alphabet and their sounds.

The children are continuing to listen to the sounds in words and blend the sounds together.



Maths

This half term, the children will be:

- organising and sequencing events
- Using positional language
- Looking at more/fewer
- Recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes
- Continuing to count with the numbers in the correct order, recognise numbers and talk about number patterns



Reading

Thank you to the parents who read daily with their children and complete the reading diaries.

Please can I remind all parents that you must spend time every day helping your child talk about their story and then sign their reading diary.

Please return your child's reading book every day. If books are not brought back to school you will have to pay a £5 fine.

Please read every night with your child at home.
